Please make sure you and your children are dressed appropriately with sensible running footwear, sun hats and sun cream (or wellies if we have some wet weather the previous day).

We appreciate many parents and carers work or don't drive and may find it difficult to either attend or work with the proposed timings. However if you still wish your child to attend you may be able to arrange something with another playgroup parent. Keyworkers can look after one or two children each but this will need to be pre-arranged and numbers will be limited.
